



France and Switzerland - 11 Nights, 12 Days:

Day 01:

Arrive Paris Airport, clear immigration, collect your luggage and transfer to your hotel. Check in hotel. (Check in post 1500 hours)

Overnight in Paris.

Day 02:

Breakfast in hotel. Proceed for a full day trip to Disneyland. Discover new attractions, experiences and your favourite Marvel super-heroes! Attractions, Disney Characters, and many more surprises await you. From thrill rides to family adventures and fun for the little ones, there's plenty to explore at Disneyland® Paris. Watch in awe as Disney stories come alive across 5 magical lands.

Spectacular shows include the fairytale flight of fancy that's Disney Illuminations! an electrifying sound and light show with the Sleeping Beauty Castle at its centre.

Explore Disney film and animation in Walt Disney Studios® Park.

Overnight in Paris.

Day 03:

Breakfast in hotel. Today proceed for the city tour of Paris. Experience the history and of Paris on a family-friendly combo tour. Sightsee around the French capital from the comfort of your coach and cruise along the Seine to admire landmarks such as the Louvre and Notre-Dame. The Eiffel Tower is the most visited attraction in the world having an entrance ticket. Built for the Paris World Exhibition in 1889, it has gone on to become one of the most widely recognized landmarks in the world, and features on almost every traveler's bucket list. Save time with a pre-booked, ticket to the second level of the Eiffel Tower via lift. Explore the tower at your leisure and take in views of some of the most well-known Parisian landmarks, including the Arc de Triomphe and the expansive Haussmann boulevards, among others.

Overnight in Paris.

Day 04:

Breakfast in hotel. Check out and proceed to Paris train station to board your train to Montreux.

Arrive Montreux and transfer to your hotel. Check in hotel. (Check in post 1500 hours)

Overnight in Montreux.

**Day 05:**

Breakfast in hotel. Today proceed for full day excursion to Glacier 3000. To get to Glacier 3000, take the Ski Bus from the town of Gstaad to the cable car station in Col du Pillon. Les Diablerets can be reached by train from Montreux via Aigle, or Gstaad (both around an hour away).

A snow-coated wonderland perched high in the Vaud Alps of Western Switzerland, the Glacier 3000 resort is a one-stop destination for outdoor enthusiasts. Just an hour from Montreux, it offers spectacular mountain views, ample opportunities for hiking and skiing, and a huge range of adrenaline-fueled activities. After riding the cable car to the 9,842-foot (3,000-meter) mountaintop of Glacier 3000, visitors can take in the views from the Botta restaurant and terrace, ride the Ice Express chairlift, and brave the Peak Walk by Tissot, the only mountain peak suspension bridge of its kind in the world. Guided tours run from Montreux, Geneva, and Lausanne, often combined with a stop in the village of Les Diablerets or at viewpoints around Lake Geneva.

Tickets for Glacier 3000 include entrance to the Fun Park, Glacier Walk, the Ice Express chairlift, and the Peak Walk. It can be chilly on the mountaintop even in the summer months, so be sure to wear appropriate clothing. The cable car and Botta restaurant are both wheelchair accessible. How to Get There To get to Glacier 3000, take the Ski Bus from the town of Les Diablerets to the cable car station in Col du Pillon. Les Diablerets can be reached by train from Montreux via Aigle, or Gstaad (both around an hour away). When to Get There The Glacier 3000 area is open all year-round, aside from a month of annual scheduled maintenance (typically late September to early October). The best time to visit depends on your chosen activities—skiers will want to visit in the winter season (October to May), while some activities, such as the alpine coaster and snow bus, are only open in the summer months (June to September). Outdoor Adventures at Glacier 3000 Along with more than 16 miles (26 kilometres) of ski and snowboard runs and a snow park, winter visitors can enjoy cross-country skiing, sledding at the Fun Park, and glacier hiking, while summer visitors can choose from a range of hiking trails or tackle the Via Ferrata climbing route. Other activities include dog sledding, helicopter flights over the glaciers, snow bus rides, and the Alpine Coaster, the world's highest toboggan run. To get to Glacier 3000, take the Skibus from the town of Les Diablerets to the cable car station in Col du Pillon. Les Diablerets can be reached from Geneva via Lausanne, Montreux, and Aigle, while it can be reached from Zurich via Bern, Spiez, and Zweisimmen.

Return to Montreux.

Overnight in Montreux.

Day 06:

Breakfast in hotel. Today take a train to Gruyeres.

Gruyeres cheese factory is opposite the train station. Cheese making timing is from 9am to 1230pm.

You can get to see how cheese is made and also taste some of it.

Post the visit to the cheese factory walk back to the Gruyeres train station to take a train to Broc Village to visit Maison Callier chocolate factory.

You can taste some of the most fine Swiss Chocolates and also shop to your heart's content.

Return to Montreux.

Overnight in Montreux.

Day 07:

Breakfast in hotel. Check out and transfer to the train station to board your Golden Pass train to Interlaken.

Arrive Interlaken and transfer to your hotel. Check in hotel. (Check in at 1500 hours).

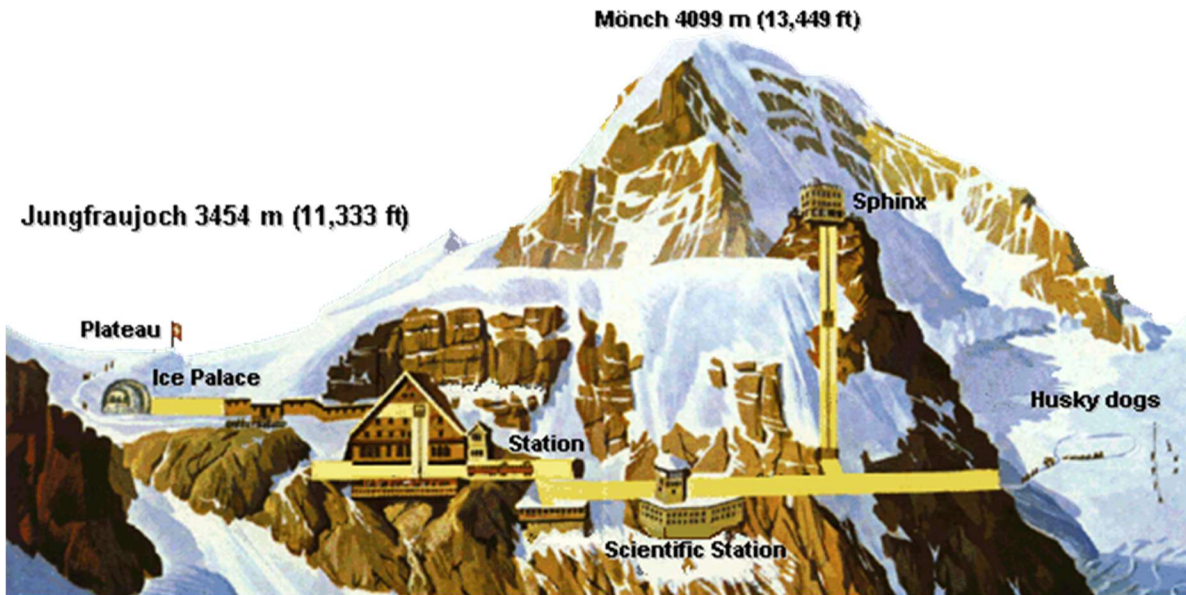
Overnight in Interlaken.

Day 08:

Breakfast in hotel. Today proceed for the full day excursion to Jungfrauoch. Take a Post bus from Interlaken West Station to Interlaken Ost Station. Swiss Pass is valid on the Post bus. You can also take a train from Interlaken West to Interlaken Ost Station.

Proceed to the Grindelwald Train Station from Interlaken. From Grindelwald you take the cable car Eiger Express to the Eiger Glacier station and then take the train to Jungfrauoch.

The new Eiger Express tricable car will take you from Grindelwald to the Eiger Glacier station in just 15 minutes. With a direct transfer option, you will be on the Jungfrauoch - Top of Europe and on the slopes 47 minutes faster than before.



Attractions on the Jungfrauoch:

- Ice Palace
- Ice Gateway
- Sphinx observation terrace
- Plateau with hikes in the eternal snow
- "Top of Europe" Glacier Restaurant
- High Alpine Research Exhibition

Points of interest:-

- The best place in Europe to discover an all-year-round wonder world of snow and ice.
- A visit to the Eiger and Jungfrau, two of the three most famous mountains in Switzerland.
- Stops at Wengen, Kleine Scheidegg and Grindelwald allow you to experience the whole Jungfrau Region in one exciting excursion.
- Sphinx - Europe's highest-altitude vantage point at 3571 meters.
- The Aletsch Glacier - the longest ice stream in the Alps, with a length of 22 km and a thickness of up to 800 meters.
- The Ice Palace, 30 meters under the surface of the glacier. You can enjoy exquisite ice sculptures.
- 05 different 'Top of Europe' restaurants - One is Bollywood - the Indian restaurant that quite literally takes Indian food to greater heights.
- Return to Interlaken.
- Overnight in Interlaken.

**Day 09:**

Breakfast in hotel. Check out and transfer to the train station to board your train to Lucerne.

Arrive Lucerne and transfer to your hotel. Keep the bags in the hotel lobby and proceed to visit the Lion Monument and Kappel Bruck Bridge.

The Lion Monument, which is nestled in a rocky grotto in a charming park setting, was unveiled in 1821. The dying lion of Lucerne was sculpted from the living rock of the cliff and commemorates the Swiss guardsmen who died in 1792 during the French Revolution. The most mournful and moving piece of stone in the world invites you to journey back through time.

However, this striking stone lion is more than “just” a monument. It commemorates the Swiss Guards who were massacred in 1792 during the French Revolution, when revolutionaries stormed the Tuileries Palace in Paris. Lucerne is especially well-known for its wooden bridges. Today, the Chapel Bridge runs from the New Town on the southern bank of the Reuss to the Rathausquai in the medieval Old Town, zigzagging as it passes the impressive Water Tower.

Lucerne's landmark is considered to be Europe's oldest covered bridge. It was built in 1332 and was originally a part of the city fortifications. The pictorial panels, which were incorporated in the 17th century, contain scenes of Swiss history as well as the Lucerne's history, including the biographies of the city's patron saints, St. Leodegar and St. Maurice.

Lucerne's water tower is a powerful yet attractive construction. This octagonal tower - over 34 meters high (111.5 ft.) - was built around 1300 as part of the city wall and used as an archive, treasury, prison and torture chamber. You can shop to your heart's content at Casagrande shop in Lucerne for Souvenirs.

Check in hotel. (Check in at 1500 hours).

Overnight in Lucerne.

Day 10:

Breakfast in hotel. Today proceed for the full day excursion to Mt Titlis. Take a train from Lucerne to Engelberg.

On arrival at Engelberg station you have to proceed to Mt. Titlis counter which is around 07 minutes walk to reach to the base of the 01st Cable Car.

Engelberg - Trübsee (20 minutes)

Gondolas for 6 people each (please remain seated when you arrive in Gerschnialp) run non-stop from 8.30 a.m. until 5.15 p.m.

Last trip up to Mount Titlis: 3.40 p.m.

2) Trübsee - Stand (5 minutes)

In Station Trübsee you have to change the cable car. With the 80-person Gondel, you ride up to Station Stand.

Operates continuously from 8.50 a.m. until 5 p.m. Last trip down to Engelberg 5 p.m.

Stand - Titlis (5 minutes)

In Station Stand you transfer to the Rotair (80-person Gondel), the first revolving gondola of the world. Enjoy a "round view panorama trip" to the top.

Please calculate a total travel time of 45 minutes.

All cable cars are wheel chair accessible. The stations have lifts, so that you reach the individual attractions without problems.

Return to Lucerne.

Overnight in Lucerne.

Day 11:

Breakfast in hotel. Check out and transfer to the train station to board your train to Zurich.

Arrive Zurich train station and proceed to your hotel. Keep bags in the hotel lobby and proceed to Zurich train station to board your train to Schaffhausen to visit Rhine Falls.

Rhine Falls are to be visited from a place called Schaffhausen. Enjoy a boat ride at the falls. You will get a discounted rate on the Swiss Pass.

This is a record - there is no other *waterfall* in Europe bigger than the Rheinfall. This is experienced in a most impressive way on a boat trip through the Rheinfall ...

A trip to the rock, a round trip in the river basin or a leisurely cruise to Rheinau are simple unforgettable experiences.



Return to Zurich.

Arrive Zurich train station and proceed to your hotel. Check in hotel.

Overnight in Zurich.

Day 12:

Check out and proceed to the Airport to board your flight back home.
