



Grand Tour England Scotland - 10 Nights/11 Days

DAY 01 Arrival at London

Arrival at London Airport, After Immigration, Transfer to respective hotel at London. This day is free (As per the flight timings) OR proceed for city orientation tour London. Covering their main cynosure i.e. Coco –cola London eye, Madam Tussauds, Museum so on so forth.

DAY 02 London – Oxford-Cotswold-Warwick Castle

Buffet breakfast at London hotel. This day proceed for sightseeing to oxford and Cotswold - Journey back in time to Merrie Olde England with this fascinating day trip taking in Oxford, the Cotswolds, and Warwick Castle. This full-day tour offers an intriguing insight into the English country and lifestyle that few visitors ever get to see. Visit the city that is home to the oldest university in the English speaking world, Experience pretty English country villages and see where William Shakespeare was born, Conquer Warwick Castle Follow in the footsteps of Oxford's famous students, from C.S. Lewis to Bill Clinton, as you stroll the impressive college courtyards and curious cobbled lanes of this historic university town. Being a centre of learning for more than 900 years has bequeathed Oxford with countless faculties, halls, libraries, chapels, and lodgings, earned it the soubriquet of the City of Dreaming Spires. Meander through the unspoilt narrow alleys and ancient squares and let them captivate you. Get the chance to see Bodleian Library which is one of the oldest libraries in Europe as well as the splendid college courtyards. On top of the walking tour, you get to set your own pace as you enjoy some free time! The rolling hills of the Cotswolds are one of England's most picturesque locations and you cast your eyes over all of it as we cruise on through. The area is a charming blend of breath-taking natural scenery, sleepy villages, and bustling market towns. Lunch at Indian restaurant – Oxford area. Back to London city.

DAY 03 London Westminster to Greenwich sightseeing Thames Cruise

Buffet breakfast at London hotel. You will proceed to see Houses of Parliament, Parliament Square, St. Paul's Cathedral, St Paul's Churchyard, HMS Belfast, The Queen's Walk, Tower of London, Cutty stark, King William Walk Greenwich, Royal Observatory Greenwich, Blackheath Avenue, Greenwich park, Greenwich market, National Maritime museum.

DAY 04 London

Buffet breakfast at London hotel. Free at your own leisure. OR you can do for some optional tour nearby London.

DAY 05 London – Manchester

Buffet breakfast at London hotel. Today you will check out from London hotel and proceed for Manchester. Take a beautiful Sight i.e. Old Trafford, Manchester United & City tour.
Overnight at Manchester.

DAY 06 Manchester – Lake District – Glasgow

Today enjoy your buffet breakfast at hotel. Check out from hotel and proceed to see orientation tour of Manchester, then arrive at famous lake district / Windermere. Enjoy the lake and small mountain beauty of Windermere / Lake district. Enjoy 45 minutes Cruise experience at Lake district- This self-guided driving tour takes you into the heart of the Lake District. You'll hear about the many towns and villages that you pass along the way and learn the history of the area- Ambleside, Ambleside, Lake District, Cumbria. Lunch at Windermere and Proceed to Scotland – Glasgow 2nd largest city. Arrival at Glasgow. Check in hotel and rest.

DAY 07 Glasgow – Sterling – Loch Lomond – Glasgow.

Today enjoy your buffet breakfast at hotel. Proceed for Glasgow City orientation tour and later proceed for Sterling tour 45 Kms Approx. Stirling is a city in central Scotland. At the heart of its old town, medieval Stirling Castle is on a craggy volcanic rock. On the Abbey Craig outcrop, the National Wallace Monument is a 19th-century tower. It overlooks the site of the 1297 Battle of Stirling Bridge, where William Wallace defeated the English. You will see National Wallace museum, Famous Sterling castle, Old town jail, the church of Holy rude, sterling art gallery. Lunch at restaurant in Sterling. Back to Glasgow en-route loch Lomond.

DAY 08 Glasgow- Inverness

Today enjoy your buffet breakfast at hotel. Check out from hotel and proceed to Inverness. Inverness is a city on Scotland's northeast coast, where the River Ness meets the Moray Firth. It's the largest city and the cultural capital of the Scottish Highlands. Its Old Town features 19th-century Inverness Cathedral, the mostly 18th-century Old High Church and an indoor Victorian Market selling food, clothing and crafts. Lunch and Dinner in Inverness. PS- You can also take an excursion to isle of Sky.

DAY 09 INVERNESS - EDINBURGH

This morning Enjoy your breakfast and city tour of Glasgow in the morning and then proceed top Edinburgh Check in hotel OR you can enjoy city orientation tour of Edinburgh. Also you will see the most famous Edinburgh Castle (As per the scheduled timings).

The three tourist attractions:

1. Edinburgh Castle is built on top of the basalt remains of an extinct volcano proving impressive views of the entire city and beyond. The oldest parts of the castle date back to the Normans but there are buildings and fortifications that cover every period since that time. The castle is home to, amongst other things, the Scottish Crown Jewels, the Stone of Destiny and the giant 15th century siege gun Mons Meg.
2. The Royal Yacht Britannia is magnificent ship and has played host to some of the most famous people in the world. But, above all, she was home to Her Majesty the Queen and the Royal Family. First commissioned 11th January 1954 this floating palace served the royal family for over forty years conveying them to 696 foreign visits, 272 visits in British waters and steamed an unbelievable 1,087,623 nautical miles!
3. The Palace of Holyrood House is the official residents of the Queen and stands at the end of Edinburgh's Royal Mile against the spectacular backdrop of Arthur's Seat. This wonderful example of baroque architecture is closely associated with Scotland's rich history. The state apartments are still used by the Queen and other members of the royal family for state ceremonies and official entertaining.
