



Grand Tour Scotland & Ireland - 10 Nights/11 Days

DAY 01 LONDON ARRIVAL – LEEDS

Upon arrival in London, take a transfer to King cross railway station. Board a train to the largest settlement in Yorkshire - LEEDS. Check in- Leeds hotel Free at Leisure. Overnight at Leeds.

DAY 02 LEEDS

Enjoy your breakfast at hotel. Visit Corn Exchange, Victorian Arcades, and Kirkgate Market. Discover the impressive heritage of this vibrant city, with its stunning architecture, rich cultural scene, and shopping opportunities. Explore the bustling Victoria Quarter. Overnight at Leeds.

DAY 03 LEEDS

Enjoy your breakfast at hotel. This day is free at your own pace or you can choose to explore the original Emmerdale filming locations. Overnight at Leeds.

DAY 04 LEEDS - Ilkley Moor

Enjoy your breakfast at hotel. This day is free at your own pace or take the train from Leeds Station to Ilkley. A scenic walk on the famous Ilkley Moor (“bar t’at”) and find the Cow and Calf; a large rock formation consisting of an outcrop and boulder, also known as Hangingstone Rocks. Return back to Leeds. Overnight at Leeds.

DAY 05 LEEDS- GLASGOW

Enjoy your breakfast at hotel, this day check out from hotel and transfer to Scotland (Glasgow) City. Check –in hotel and later take orientation tour of Glasgow – City tour, Wheel, Museum, National art gallery, Clyde river etc. Overnight at Glasgow.

DAY 06 GLASGOW – EDINBURGH EXCURSION

Enjoy your breakfast at hotel, Proceed for Edinburgh Excursion, Orientation tour of Edinburgh castle (Admission tickets extra), Holyrood Palace (Entrance ticket Extra) , Royal Mile Etc. Also proceed for distillery tour Either from Glasgow or on return from Edinburgh.

The Royal Yacht Britannia is magnificent ship and has played host to some of the most famous people in the world. But, above all, she was home to Her Majesty the Queen and the Royal Family. First commissioned 11th January 1954 this floating palace served the royal family for over forty years conveying them to 696 foreign visits, 272 visits in British waters and steamed an unbelievable 1,087,623 nautical miles!

The Palace of Holyrood House is the official residence of the Queen and stands at the end of Edinburgh's Royal Mile against the spectacular backdrop of Arthur's Seat. This wonderful example of baroque architecture is closely associated with Scotland's rich history. The state apartments are still used by the Queen and other members of the royal family for state ceremonies and official entertaining.

Overnight at Glasgow.

DAY 07 GLASGOW – DUBLIN

Enjoy your breakfast at Glasgow hotel. Time to check out and transfer to Dublin by coach. (Surface and Boat) Arrival at Dublin, enjoy your lunch. Check –in and relax at hotel. Overnight at Dublin.

DAY 08 DUBLIN - Cliffs of Moher, Burren & Galway

Get your breakfast in the morning, Embark on a scenic day trip from Dublin to explore the Cliffs of Moher, Galway, and the Burren, travel along the famous Wild Atlantic Way. Enjoy stunning landscapes, historic landmarks, and a mix of Ireland's best cultural and natural attractions. Overnight at Dublin.



DAY 09 DUBLIN - Giants Causeway, Dark Hedges, Dunluce & Belfast

After breakfast, Discover Northern Ireland's dramatic coastal route on a day trip to the Giant's Causeway from Dublin. Visit the Dark Hedges, Dunluce Castle, and spend some time in Belfast.

Overnight at Dublin.

DAY 10 DUBLIN

Breakfast and step out to take a walking tour of Dublin's city center. Hear about the history of the city as you pass by landmarks such as Dublin Castle, Christchurch Cathedral, Trinity College, and more.

Overnight at Dublin.
